Form a Bond with your officiant – be honest, open and allow him or her to learn about you as a couple.

Speak From the Heart - your vows, should reflect the magnitude of the commitment you are about to make. Not be embarrassing or cryptic. You can write them yourself or select something prewritten that speaks to you.

Combine Cultures - Personalize your ceremony with elements from both your cultural backgrounds.

Plan Ahead – Select rituals that reflect who you are as a couple, be unique. Take the time to figure out how to make your ceremony different. You don't have to break a glass or light a candle.

Include Your Whole Crew - The ceremony is a great time to honor important family members and close friends who aren't in your wedding party. Maybe choose several short readings performed by special readers.

Stick to Your Guns – Do not let anyone tell you what you are doing is wrong. You need to be comfortable and happy with your choices, it is your wedding after all! If what you want is possible, ask your officiant to help you.
